



## INSTRUCTION

Thammasat University was founded in 1934 as the University of Moral and Political Science. Thammasat became the center for studies in Law and Political Science. By 1949, there were 4 major fields of study: Law, Commerce and Accountancy, Political Science and Diplomacy, Economics. In 1952 the name was changed to Thammasat University.

The University offers instruction throughout the year in the following:

- a) Two 16-week semesters and one 6-week summer session for Undergraduate students, one 8-week summer session for Graduate students.
- b) Three 14-week semesters for Master Program of the Faculty of Commerce and Accountancy.

Thammasat University employs three systems of grading.


