


DIAGRAM OF EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM

DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR CREDENTIAL EVALUATION

HIGHER EDUCATION:

WES requires clear, legible photocopies of all graduation certificates or diplomas issued in English by the institutions attended to be submitted to WES by applicant. Academic transcripts issued in English must be sent directly to WES by institutions attended. For completed doctoral programs, a letter confirming the awarding of the degree is required to be sent directly to WES by institutions attended.

SECONDARY EDUCATION:

Examination results issued in English by the Ministry of Education or the Technical and Vocational Training Corporation (TVTC) to be sent directly to WES by the appropriate Regional Office of the Ministry of Education or the Technical and Vocational Training Corporation.
